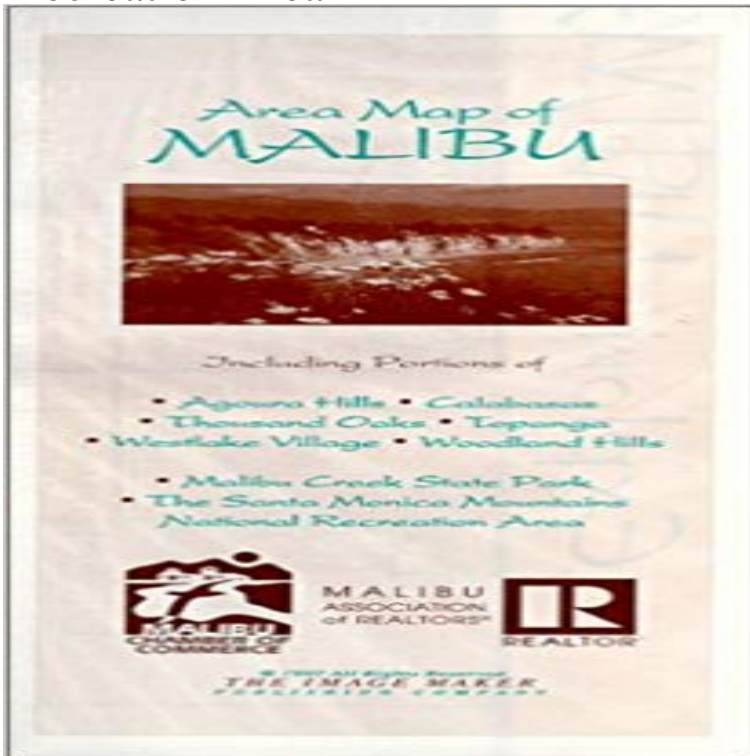


Area Map of Malibu: Including The Santa Monica Mountains National Recreation Area
