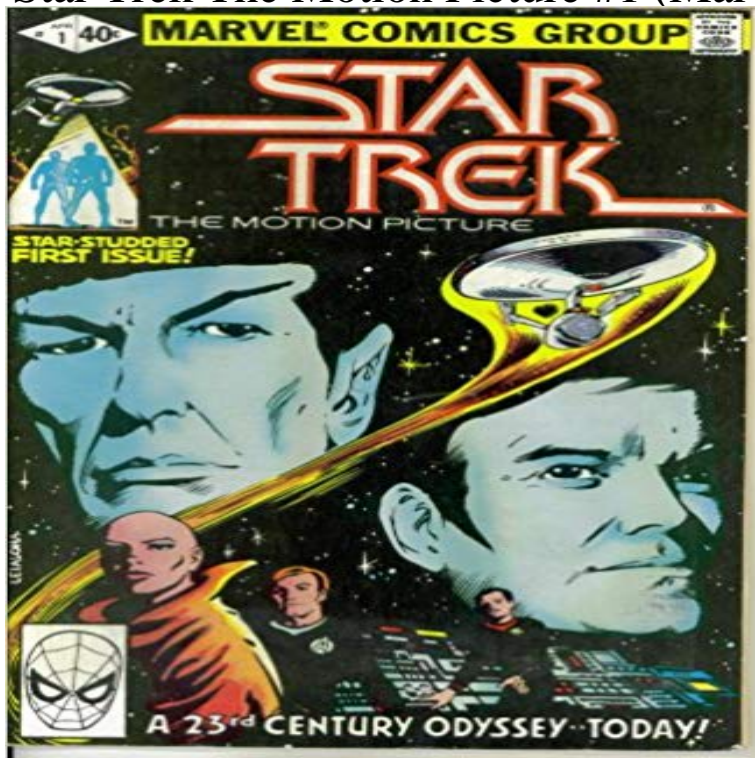


## Star Trek The Motion Picture #1 (Marvel Comics)
