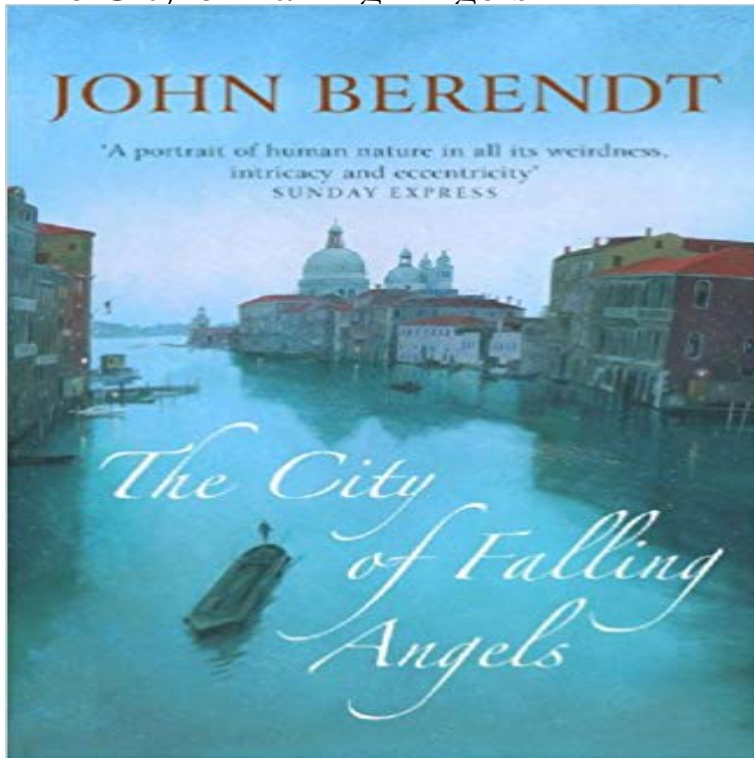


# The City of Falling Angels
