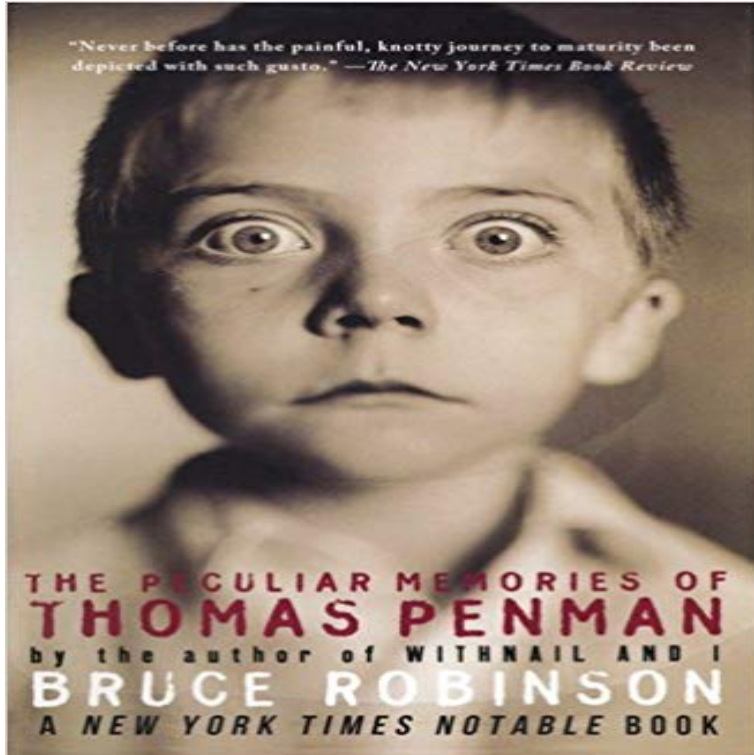


Peculiar Memories of Thomas Penman
