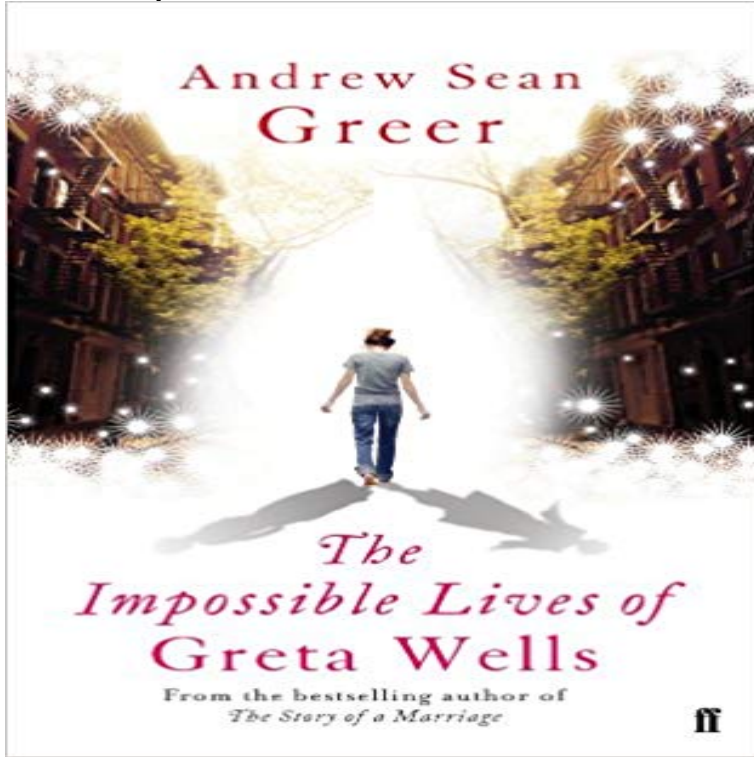


The Impossible Lives of Greta Wells
